Because it's not necessarily the team who wins the most games that is crowned champion, all levels and abilities can enter into the tournament in the name of competitiveness, fun and fundraising. Teams sell raffle tickets, collect pledges and come up with other great ways to raise money. Each team is given a "Fundraising Invoice" at the end of their games where they are charged \$5 for every goal they scored! The new CT is up and running at LWDH and Hockey for Health 3 on 3 will help us make that final payment! Allowing us to move onto the next project.
