

LWDH Foundation Board Chair Report

Once again this year it is my pleasure to report on behalf of the Hospital Foundation Board of Directors and staff that we have had another very successful year. Thanks to the overwhelming generosity of our communities, the Foundation was able to transfer \$1,360,000 to the Lake of the Woods Hospital this fiscal year!

Though it may seem like so long ago now, the foundation got off to an incredible start in 2019, hosting our annual 3on 3 Hockey for health in April raising over \$58,000 followed by the volunteer driven 2nd Annual Father Daughter ball, held at the Clarion Lakeside Inn raising \$14,650. For 10 years MNP sponsored an amazing golf tournament in support of the hospital raising over \$500,000 from 2008-2018 for which the foundation and the hospital will always be grateful. In 2019 The Dingwall Group came forward with a brand new concept... for the Par 3 Charity Challenge, selling out in a matter of



weeks and raised \$108,000. As the summer came to a close, our friends on the lake held their Annual Lifesavers Dinner and Auction, last year co-chaired by Lisa Patterson and Dominque Kyle, who with the help of our cherished summer residents, mixed with some of our valuable locals raised \$344,000! A new record for this event! As summer faded into fall the Tree of Life once again came to life in our community, followed shortly after that and with luck was still able to take place before the pandemic hit, 89.5 the Lake's Curling for a Cause. These are just some of the amazing events and donations the hospital benefited from last year, and we want to say thank you to each and everyone of you who sponsored, participated, or donated in support of these events. Every donation matters.

Without your support the hospital foundation could not have purchased over \$1.36 million of equipment last year. While this is great news and reason for celebration, I would be remiss if I didn't mention the Global Pandemic which your Foundation began to feel the effects of in March, and will continue to feel the effects of for some time to come. While this report will only reflect a minor impact to the hospital, the next 12 months will be an extremely challenging one. Not only will our front line staff and administration, who work tirelessly day in and day out be impacted, our fund raising will also be impacted. In order to keep us all safe LWDHF was forced to postpone several major events due to the social distancing restrictions imposed on our community by both the provincial and federal governments. So as you move forward through the next 12 months I ask that you look for some of the new socially distanced fundraising events and consider supporting your hospital in new and creative ways!






















Who is LWDHF?

The Lake of the Woods District Hospital Foundation (LWDHF) was established in 1992 and continues to be the lifeline between your community and your hospital. LWDHF is governed by an eleven member board, has three employees and benefits from over 2000 volunteer hours per year. Within the board are Finance, Publicity, Governance and Executive committees who meet monthly in addition to our monthly board meeting. We are dedicated to raising funds for the purchase of medical equipment and capital infrastructure.

Since our inception, we have transferred over \$21.4 million to Lake of the Woods District Hospital (LWDH) which was constructed in 1929 and has had many additions over the years. Your hospital currently houses a staff of over 515 in addition to the services of 32 doctors and 18 specialists. LWDH serves a catchment population of 25,000 for primary care and 90,000 for secondary specialist care. In the summer months, these numbers increase to over 70,000 and 150,000 respectfully.

The Ontario Ministry of Health and Long Term Care provide on average, 80% of our hospital's operating costs. This limited funding for healthcare increases the financial pressure for our hospital in addition to the fact that none of this funding covers capital expenses. There isn't a matching funds program through the Ministry for capital equipment which leaves LWDHF to raise the funds dollar for dollar. The funds raised by LWDHF allow your hospital to maintain the high level of quality healthcare that their patients expect, appreciate and deserve. With medical technology continually advancing and the daily workings of our hospital creating a need to constantly maintain and improve its interior, our cause is ongoing and endless. Without supporters from the community and beyond, the capital needs of your hospital would be unattainable. By working with your community and your hospital, we can continue to move forward together and ensure that quality healthcare remains available for your family, your friends, for your community.

The support LWDHF receives from our community is remarkable. Our community has embraced us as a partner in working towards providing the best possible healthcare available. You have adopted your hospital as a cause close to your heart which together we continue to nurture and support year after year.

A Donor Bill of Rights

Philanthropy is based on voluntary action for the common good. It is a tradition of giving and sharing that is primary to the quality of life. To assure that philanthropy merits the respect and trust of the general public, and that donors and prospective donors can have full confidence in the not-for-profit organizations and causes they are asked to support, we declare that all donors have these rights:

- 1. To be informed of the organization's mission, of the way the organization intends to use donated resources, and of its capacity to use donations effectively for their intended purposes.
- 2. To be informed of the identity of those serving on the organization's governing board, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
- 3. To have access to the organization's most recent financial statements.
- 4. To be assured their gifts will be used for the purposes for which they were given.
- 5. To receive appropriate acknowledgment and recognition.
- 6. To be assured that information about their donations is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.
- 7. To expect that all relationships with individuals representing organizations of interest to the donor will be professional in nature.
- 8. To be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers, employees of the organization or hired solicitors.
- 9. To have the opportunity for their names to be deleted from mailing lists that an organization may intend to share.
- 10.To feel free to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful and forthright answers.

Donor Categories

Lake of the Woods District Hospital Foundation takes pride in acknowledging their donors using our website, our Facebook fan page and listing contributors on our donor board found in LWDH's main lobby.

Our Donor Recognition Board celebrates individuals and organizations according to their level of support. The Donor Recognition Board also celebrates any tributes that are established with our charity.

The board is prominently located along the main hallway from the ER Entrance. All donations and tributes are noted on a cumulative basis, since the Foundation's inception in 1992. It is updated annually.
