Lake of the Woods District Hospital (LWDH) is an acute-care hospital located in Kenora, Ontario. We serve a catchment population of 32,000 people for primary care, 90,000 people for secondary specialists care, spread over a vast geography, including 10 First Nation communities and a large seasonal population. The LWDH Emergency Department provides 24-hour care for persons requiring urgent care. Beyond numerous outpatient services, LWDH supports a busy visiting specialist program and community Mental Health & Addictions programming.

Because of your extraordinary generosity, the Foundation will also fund a new Central Monitoring System and invest over \$2.5 million through the Excellence Fund for high-priority equipment upgrades across the Hospital to enhance patient care.

This campaign became more than a fundraiser; it became a movement of community pride. Every gift, large or small, reflected hope and trust in our shared future. Matching partners like the FDC Foundation and leadership from families and local businesses made this truly a collective achievement.

BRUCE SAMSON

Bruce was a long-time Winnipeg resident who spent many joyful summers at West Hawk Lake. A dad of three and spirited entrepreneur, he was highly involved in his community and passionate about helping others. He was a camp counsellor at Camp Stephens, sailed in many LOWISA regattas, and made lifelong friends during his adventures. Bruce eventually retired to his Lake of the Woods cottage he built in his early 20s; his son lan stated that Bruce enjoyed "many years living the Lake Life. The lake is where dad taught us to swim, waterski and sail."

In his later years, Bruce received treatment at the Lake of the Woods District Hospital (LWDH) for two different types of cancer. Both times, Bruce acknowledged the outstanding care and kindness he received from the medical staff and caregivers in Kenora. This is when Bruce made the decision to pay tribute to the care he was provided, while ensuring LWDH staff would continue to be equipped with the tools they need to provide great care, at the lake.

On February 25, 2023, Bruce passed away at age 91, at his home in British Columbia after living a full life. The LWDH Foundation is grateful for the \$25,000 gift received from the Estate of Bruce Samson. Bruce's gift towards Diagnostic Imaging enhancements will help to shape the future at our hospital while creating a legacy of care for generations to come.

2024 PAR 3 CHARITY CHALLENGE

DRIVEN BY THE DINGWALL GROUP

\$225,252 RAISED FOR AN ADVANCED MAMMOGRAPHY UNIT







Under hot, sunny skies on July 11, 2024, golfers and volunteers gathered for the 4th Annual Par 3 Charity Challenge, driven by The Dingwall Group. The event raised an impressive \$225,252 to help fund a new Mammography Unit at the Lake of the Woods District Hospital (LWDH). With this replacement, mammography capabilities will be upgraded to include tomography, contrast-enhanced imaging, and stereotactic biopsies – more services close to home.

The all-inclusive 18-hole golf event saw remarkable participation and generosity from the community, with a full slate of golfers, 70 sponsors, and 85 volunteers contributing to its success. A highlight of the day was the Golf Ball Drop, which, for the second year running, captivated attendees. Jarnel Contracting's crane hoisted 500 pre-sold, numbered golf balls 20 feet above the 18th green, with Linda I. from Kenora winning the \$3,000 closest-to-the-hole prize.

The success of the Par 3 tournament was driven by the strong commitment to healthcare excellence demonstrated by Kenora and regional business sponsors. The advanced mammography unit, installed in November 2024, has now performed over 1,500 studies as of July 1, 2025. For the first time, patients in our region have access to contrast-enhanced imaging and stereotactic biopsies at LWDH; services that are making a real difference in early detection and treatment of breast cancer.

37th ANNUAL TREE OF LIFE

ILLUMINATING THE PATH TO BETTER CARE, TOGETHER

The 37th Annual Tree of Life Appeal was a shining success and we are deeply grateful to our incredible community for an outpouring of support in December 2024!

A special Giving Tuesday event on December 3, 2024 powered the Tree of Life Campaign with three participation-based Match Challenges.

Donors doubled their contributions through the generosity of three local match donors: Leelan and Lori Pearson from Northern Hearing, Dr. Rourke Christiuk from Kenora Optometry Clinic and Dr. Hyeongu Kim from Kenora Family Dental also joined as match donors, amplifying the community's collective impact.

"Having excellent health care at LWDH is a boon to our community," Leelan remarked, emphasizing the importance of reducing the need for patients to travel for essential care.

In just 10 hours (even with a ton of snow falling), donations from individuals, families and businesses poured in online, in-person, and over the phone to meet the three match challenges. Within a 24-hour period an outpouring of generosity left Foundation staff overwhelmed and grateful. This momentum continued throughout December, helping to raise a grand total of \$53,383 for the 2024 Tree of Life.

The funds raised were used to support the purchase of the new, advanced Mammography Unit. Installed in late November 2024, this cutting-edge technology is already enhancing care for patients in Kenora and across Northwestern Ontario.

A GIFT OF GRATITUDE

HONOURING EMERGENCY CARE AT LWDH

When care is delivered with compassion, excellence, and professionalism, it stays with you. That's what inspired Doug Harvey and Jan Shute to make an extraordinary \$50,000 Gift of Gratitude to the Lake of the Woods District Hospital Foundation in honour and appreciation of Dr. Moore and the Emergency Department (ED) team.

After a health issue arose that required 11-straight days of intravenous antibiotics twice daily, the Harvey family experienced first-hand the exceptional care provided by the LWDH team.

From thoughtful follow-up to seamless collaboration with specialists, their experience left a lasting impression. In appreciation, Doug and Jan made a meaningful donation to recognize the staff and enhance the tools they use to care for others every day.

Their one request: that the funds be used directly in the Emergency Department to support patients and staff with practical, high-impact equipment.

Working alongside Emergency Department leadership and Dr. Sean Moore, several essential items were identified and purchased, including:

- A Ring Rescue Kit, allowing staff to safely and efficiently remove rings from swollen or injured hands using a compression device or electric cutter — both safe and non-destructive methods.
- Youth-sized hospital gowns, available in three soft, snap-closure sizes, providing warmth, comfort, and dignity for the youngest patients.
- Rolling black stools, giving staff increased mobility and helping reduce fatigue during long shifts.
- Self-sanitizing charging lockers, installed in the ED waiting room so patients and families can safely charge their devices while they wait.
- A new otoscope, improving the speed and accuracy of patient assessments.

"These kinds of tools may seem simple, but they make a real difference in how we care for people," said Dr. Moore. "We are incredibly grateful to Doug and Jan for their generosity and for recognizing the important work our team does every day."

"We learned first-hand how lucky we are, to have such competent and caring staff in the Hospital at our beloved Lake of the Woods." The Harvey and Shute Family's gift is already making a difference, one that will continue to support and uplift care at LWDH for years to come.







BEYOND THE SCAN CAMPAIGN

RAISES \$9,522,151 TO ADVANCE LOCAL HEALTHCARE

Spurred by urgent needs in our Diagnostic Imaging Department, Beyond the Scan is the most ambitious capital campaign in the Foundation's history. With a bold \$8.5 million goal (surpassed in record time thanks to the extraordinary generosity of our community) the campaign is transforming access to care across Northwestern Ontario. At its heart is a clear and powerful vision: to establish a fully equipped, fully operational Diagnostic Imaging Centre of Excellence at LWDH by fall 2025 that includes:

- Kenora's first-ever MRI machine: This machine will be installed soon and will be operational by the Fall of 2025. The MRI will reduce the need for long travel, reduce wait times, and enable faster, more accurate diagnoses.
- CT Scanner Replacement: The hospital's nearly decade-old CT scanner will soon be replaced. The Diagnostic Imaging team is preparing to issue an Request for Proposal this winter to acquire the most suitable technology available.
- An advanced Mammography Unit: Installed in November 2024, this system offers enhanced imaging capabilities. To date, over 1,500 studies have been performed and new services that began in March 2025 include Contrast-Enhanced Imaging and Stereotactic Biopsy.
- \$3.5M in upgrades in multiple departments through the Excellence Fund: Thanks to the extraordinary generosity of our community, the additional \$1 million raised beyond the original \$8.5 million goal is enabling \$3.5 million in upgrades across multiple hospital departments through the Excellence Fund. Of this total, \$1 million is dedicated to the urgently-needed replacement of the Central Monitoring System. This critical technology enhances patient safety by allowing care teams to continuously monitor vital signs in real time across the Emergency Department, ICU, 3E, Surgical Services, and Maternity.

"Many in our community struggle to travel for care. Whether it's seniors, individuals without reliable transportation, or those with mobility challenges, access to local diagnostic imaging is crucial. Women in our community deserve top-tier breast cancer screening, and our aging population requires timely and accurate diagnoses. This campaign is about more than just machines, it's about health equity, accessibility, and quality of life."

CHEMISTRY ANALYZER BOOSTS PATIENT CARE AT LWDH


The Lake of the Woods District Hospital (LWDH) is proud to announce the arrival of a new, state-of-the-art Chemistry Analyzer—a vital upgrade to the hospital's laboratory services that will significantly enhance patient care.

Each year, LWDH conducts more than 438,000 lab procedures, and the Chemistry Analyzer is at the heart of that work. This 2,000-pound machine rapidly processes tissue and fluid samples, delivering critical diagnostic information to physicians with improved speed and accuracy. These timely results support better-informed clinical decisions, faster diagnoses, and more effective treatment plans for patients across our region.

While most hospital-grade analyzers require structural modifications for installation, Siemens Healthcare provided a compact model that fit through the lab doors with less than an inch to spare, avoiding costly renovations. This \$203,000 investment was made possible through the generosity of our supporters, including a \$150,000 donation from the FDC Foundation and \$53,000 raised through the LWDH Foundation's monthly online lottery.

Thanks to this new equipment, LWDH's laboratory team is now better equipped than ever to deliver efficient, high-quality diagnostic testing, helping ensure patients receive the right care, at the right time.

Investing in Faster, Smarter Lab Diagnostics at LWDH

LEARNING & INNOVATION

LWDH INVESTS IN STATE-OF-THE-ART TRAINING TOOLS THANKS TO A \$10,000 RBC EDUCATION GRANT

In May 2025, LWDH received a generous \$10,000 boost from the RBC Foundation, funding a major upgrade to its clinical training tools. With some additional help from the LWDHF 50/50 revenue, cutting-edge intravenous (IV) and auscultation simulators were purchased. Until recently, staff trained on an 12-year old IV model that leaked. Now, with lifelike simulators - including one with a darker skin tone to reflect the region's diverse population nurses, technologists, and medical students can sharpen their skills in a setting that better mirrors real-life patient care.

Staff from the Emergency Department, ICU, Maternity, the OR, and Diagnostic Imaging stand to benefit most. Frequent, realistic practice helps staff maintain confidence and precision, especially when inserting IVs in patients with hard-to-find veins due to age, illness, or other factors.

A standout feature of the upgrade is an ultrasoundguided IV insertion trainer, supporting a technique that aligns with recommendations from the Canadian Vascular Association. The newly purchased state-ofthe-art auscultation trainer helps staff recognize abnormal heart, lung, and bowel sounds. This is especially valuable during viral illness outbreaks.

Thanks to the RBC Foundation's support, LWDH is improving training and investing in safer, smarter care. The new tools empower staff to deliver highquality treatment with greater confidence, accuracy, and cultural sensitivity; an investment that echoes far beyond the hospital walls.



GIVING FROM THE HEART

CINDY MELENCHENKO'S FAMILY STORY



For Cindy Melenchenko, charitable giving is a way of life—something intentional and deeply rooted in her values. "Giving has to be a habit, a priority in your life," she explains. It's a philosophy she and her sister have lived by and passed on, teaching Cindy's nieces the importance of saving, spending, and giving with purpose. Raised in a family that valued generosity, Cindy believes those early lessons gave her the freedom and ability to support others and the responsibility to carry that legacy forward.

In December 2024, the Lake of the Woods District Hospital Foundation reached out to thank Cindy for her continued support of the Tree of Life Appeal—an annual campaign that recently helped fund a new advanced mammography unit at LWDH. One of only two of its kind in North America, this leading-edge technology enhances diagnostic precision and significantly reduces wait times for breast cancer patients in Kenora and Northwestern Ontario.

For Cindy, this initiative resonated on a profoundly personal level. Her grandmother, Elsie Prokulevich, worked at LWDH in the 1990s and received breast cancer treatment there herself. Her journey, marked by strength, independence, and quiet generosity, left an indelible mark on Cindy and her family.

Cindy shared, "It struck me that this new technology offers a future of hope for breast cancer patients, for better diagnoses, treatments, and improved survival rates. Who knows what future hope there is for others now that we have technology like this?"

Elsie was not only a beloved figure in her family but also a pillar in her community. Originally from Garland, Northern Manitoba, she settled in Kenora with her husband Paul, where the two became active volunteers, especially within the Ukrainian Catholic Church. Whether through time, kindness, or resources, Elsie embodied the spirit of giving. In a time when survival often depended on the strength of one's neighbors, she lived by that principle and passed it on to generations to come.







\$2,046,863 invested in new equipment & technology at LWDH

2024–25 was a remarkable year marked by incredible generosity toward our most ambitious capital campaign to date. While the majority of gifts supported this transformative effort, designated contributions to other priorities also made an important impact. Together, every donation, regardless of size, helped advance patient care at LWDH and ensure the hospital's highest-priority equipment needs were met.

From April 1, 2024, to March 31, 2025, an incredible 1,539 donors made 3,834 gifts.
